Baldwin to Host Business Seminar *For Companies Interested in Export Market*

Congresswoman Tammy Baldwin will host a seminar on Tuesday, February 16, from 1:30 – 4:30 PM for Wisconsin small and medium-sized businesses looking to grow their exports or enter the export market with support from U.S. government programs.

Joining Congresswoman Baldwin at the seminar will be Fred P. Hochberg, Chairman and President of the Export-Import Bank of the United States. Presentations and discussions will be led by representatives of the U.S. Department of Commerce, the Small Business Administration, and the Export-Import Bank.

“To grow our economy and create jobs, we must take full advantage of the global marketplace,” said Congresswoman Baldwin. “I’m delighted to offer this help to local businesses wishing to enter the export market or expand their reach internationally. I’m hosting this seminar to make local businesses more aware of the federal funds and services available to help them reach their full potential,” Baldwin said.

“In the last five years, the Export-Import Bank has financed almost \$390 million in exports from Wisconsin supporting 107 companies across the state,” said Export-Import Bank Chairman and President Hochberg. “Congresswoman Baldwin and I hope this seminar will give more Wisconsin companies the tools they need to compete and succeed in the world marketplace,” Hochberg said.
