David Crowley Sworn-in to State Legislature

MADISON, WI – Newly elected State Representative David Crowley (D-Milwaukee) was sworn in today as a member of the 103rd Wisconsin State Legislature. Crowley was welcomed to the Assembly in a private swearing in ceremony conducted by Supreme Court Justice Shirley Abrahamson and joined in a public ceremony with all 99 members of his colleagues in the Wisconsin Assembly.

“While I am honored and humbled on this momentous occasion, I know that my work has just begun,” stated Crowley. “We must do more to ensure a robust Wisconsin economy, create family supporting jobs, and a stronger middle class. Currently, too many of us find ourselves working longer hours for less pay. At the same time, the cost of higher education and childcare make it difficult for hard working Wisconsinites to get ahead. We can, and must, provide greater support for our public schools to ensure a well-trained and well-educated workforce. This should be a top priority as we look to bring new, well-paying jobs to Milwaukee and across Wisconsin.”

Representative Crowley will serve on the following Assembly Committees: Criminal Justice and Public Safety, Transportation, Small Business Development, Jobs and Economy, and Workforce Development. He is also looking forward to his new role as Chair of the Milwaukee Delegation for the 2017-18 legislative session.

Representative Crowley represents the 17th Assembly District, replacing former State Representative LaTonya Johnson who ran successfully for the 6th Senate District. The 17th District encompasses portions of the near northeast side of the City of Milwaukee.
