### **Rep. Jesse Kremer Sworn Into Office for a Second Term**

Madison, WI – Yesterday, Representative Jesse Kremer (R-Kewaskum) took the oath of office and was officially sworn in to the 103<sup>rd</sup> Wisconsin Legislature. Rep. Kremer is known as a common sense, unabashed conservative voice for the 59<sup>th</sup> Assembly District. The representative is one of 64 Republicans who will be representing the Assembly during the 2017-2018 legislative session.

Thirty-nine year old Rep. Kremer was joined at the inaugural ceremony by his wife Janet, and daughters Keturah (age 13), Miriam (11) and Michaiah (7).
