EXECUTIVE ORDER #2

Relating to Recognizing and Respecting State Employees

WHEREAS, each day state employees strive to perform their jobs with professionalism and a deep commitment to public service and the people of the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, millions of Wisconsinites benefit from the services provided as a result of the hard work and dedication of state employees each and every day; and

WHEREAS, the work of our state employees is vital to making government more responsive and effective in meeting the needs of Wisconsinites; and

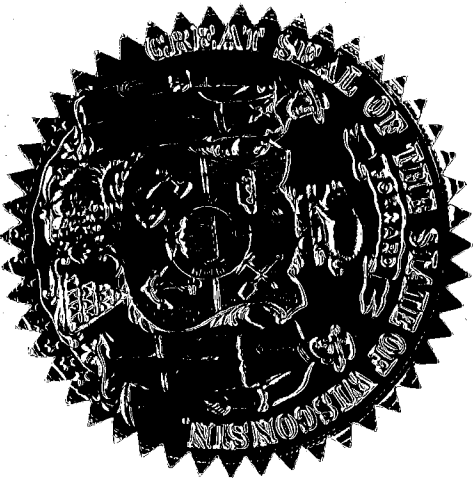
WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has a long and proud history of valuing public employees and valuing public services; and

WHEREAS, treating employees with dignity and respect improves the quality of services, promotes a stable workforce, and fosters good government;




1. Cabinet Secretaries shall actively work to recognize the valuable contributions of state employees, promote positive morale, and foster a collaborative work environment; and
2. State Agencies shall provide state employees meaningful and regular opportunities for input and feedback to Agency leadership; and
3. Each Cabinet Secretary shall evaluate staff morale and turnover rate and, as necessary, develop strategies to recruit and retain the best and brightest Wisconsin workers;
