PLUMER INAUGURATED FOR FIRST FULL TERM

Madison... On Tuesday afternoon, Rep. Jon Plumer was inaugurated for his first full term in the Wisconsin State Assembly. During the official inauguration ceremony in the Assembly chamber, all 99 members of the State Assembly were sworn in for a two year term. Plumer was first elected in a special election on June 6, 2018 and was reelected during the general election on November 6, 2018.

During the 2019-2020 session, Plumer will serve as the Chair of the Assembly Committee on Substance Abuse & Prevention. He will also serve on the following committees: Aging & Long Term Care; Agriculture; Family Law; Rural Development; Tourism; and Transportation.

Plumer commented, "I could not be more excited to begin my first full term in office as a State Representative. It is time to put our campaigns and politics aside and get to work for the people of Wisconsin. As we enter into a divided government, things will work a bit differently as they have for the past decade. However, I am confident that we will be able to reach across the aisle and accomplish what we were all sent to Madison to do."

"As the Chair of the new committee on Substance Abuse & Prevention, I am committed to working together with anyone in this building who is passionate about these issues. Unfortunately, substance abuse is destroying families across Wisconsin. I am ready to get to work to do what we can to slow this epidemic and get our citizens back on the right track and working toward clean living.", Plumer said.

Plumer, a resident of the Town of Lodi, represents portions of the following counties: Fond du Lac, Dodge, Columbia, Marquette, Dane, and Green Lake.
