Rep. Swearingen Sworn in for Fourth Term

Madison, WI – Representative Rob Swearingen (R-Rhineland) released the following statement after being sworn in for his fourth term in the Wisconsin State Assembly.

Representative Swearingen is one of 63 Assembly Republicans in the 2019-2020 legislative session.
