## Rep. Rob Stafsholt Statement on State of the State Address

**MADISON, WIS.** – Representative Rob Stafsholt (R-New Richmond) issued the following statements after Governor Walker’s State of the State address, given Tuesday afternoon to the joint session of the Wisconsin State Legislature –

“It was an honor to attend my first State of the State address this afternoon as an elected Representative.
