Rep. Don Vruwink Escorts the Governor at State of the State Address

MADISON – Today, State Representative Don Vruwink (D-Milton) was chosen to escort Governor Scott Walker into the Assembly chambers for the annual State of the State address.

“It was an honor to escort the Governor during my very first State of the State address as the Representative from the 43rd Assembly District,” Rep. Vruwink said. “After listening to the Governor’s speech, it is clear that we have a lot of work to do in Wisconsin. However, it is also clear that we have the capacity and potential to work on the issues that will help move Wisconsin forward. As lawmakers, we must put people over politics by reaching across the aisle and working together on these issues for the good of our communities and state.”

Before being elected to the Wisconsin State Assembly in November 2016, Rep. Vruwink taught history and social studies at Milton High School and coached softball, basketball and football. Rep. Vruwink has been appointed to the Committees on Agriculture, Colleges and Universities, Education, Rural Development and Mining, and Tourism for the 2017-2018 legislative session.
