Speaker Appoints Kleefisch to Key Committees

Madison – Assembly Speaker Robin Vos has placed Representative Joel Kleefisch on four vital committees including the Family Law Committee, the Corrections Committee and the State Affairs Committee. Kleefisch will chair the Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage.

The Family Law Committee addresses bills dealing with marriage, divorce, child custody, parents' rights and grandparents' rights. The Corrections Committee handles issues affecting the Department of Corrections and the prison system. The State Affairs Committee is in charge of state policy and administration of state government. It often handles issues relating to alcohol, gambling and tobacco. And the Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage Committee focuses on issues related to hunting and fishing, endangered resources, watercraft and wildlife management.

"Joel brings a great deal of experience, insight and leadership to these committees," said Speaker Robin Vos. "I'm confident he will not only serve his constituents, but also the state of Wisconsin well by working on legislation in these issue areas."
