Rep. Macco Requests “Open for Business” Boards Removed from the “Welcome to Wisconsin” Signs

Madison...Today, State Representative John Macco (R-Ledgeview) sent a letter to Wisconsin Department of Administration Secretary Joel Brennan requesting one of the “Open for Business” boards that the Evers Administration recently removed from the “Welcome to Wisconsin” signs. Representative Macco released the following statement:

“I am concerned that the “Open for Business” boards have been removed from the “Welcome to Wisconsin” signs at our state’s borders and replaced with the name of our new Governor. While Governor Evers’ administration certainly has the right to do this, I disagree with this decision. I feel that it is important to communicate to both Wisconsinites and those who are considering conducting business in our state that Wisconsin continues to be a state that is in terrific financial condition and has a robust economy. With that in mind, I requested Secretary Brennan to provide me with one of these now unused boards to display in my Madison legislative office,” said Rep. Macco.
