PLUMER SUPPORTS MIDDLE CLASS TAX CUTS

Madison... Today, Assembly Republicans unveiled a new initiative that will put hard earned tax dollars right back into the pockets of the taxpayers. Under Republican leadership over the past eight years, Wisconsin has practiced sound budgeting practices. As a result, the State of Wisconsin has a surplus of over \$588 million. The best thing to do with that money is to give it right back to the people that earned it. Governor Evers' initial plan was to eliminate the Manufacturing & Agriculture Tax Credit. This would have had a devastating effect on farmers and manufacturers in Wisconsin. The Assembly Republican plan accomplishes the same goal without raising taxes on anyone.

This proposal gives \$340 in tax relief for middle class families and individuals. Families making less than \$150,000 a year and individuals making less than \$100,000 will see the biggest benefits. It is estimated that median income families filing jointly will see a \$310 reduction in their net taxes. Should this bill get signed into law by Governor Evers, it will be a first step in moving Wisconsin forward in a bipartisan way.

Rep. Plumer (R-Lodi) commented on the proposal, "I am excited to stand with my colleagues to help Governor Evers fulfill a campaign promise to provide tax relief to Wisconsin families. Wisconsinites chose a divided government and expect us to work together. By proposing to cut middle class taxes along with Governor Evers, that is what we are doing. "

"Families across the 42nd Assembly District and throughout the state work hard for a living. By giving surplus tax dollars back to the families that earned it, they decide how to spend it. I encourage my colleagues on both sides of the aisle, along with Governor Evers, to support this plan – the people of Wisconsin are counting on us," Plumer continued.
