REP. KEITH RIPP'S RESPONSE TO THE ASSEMBLY REPUBLICAN CAUCUS PLAN FOR THE STATE'S TRANSPORTATION FUND AND TAX RELIEF

Madison, WI – State Representative Keith Ripp (R-Lodi) issued the following statement in response to the Assembly Republican Caucus plan to fund transportation and provide tax relief to Wisconsin residents.

“I am excited to join with my Assembly Republican colleagues in introducing a tax relief and common sense reforms package of at least \$300 million dollars. A recent Legislative Fiscal Bureau memo revealed that the Wisconsin State Legislature will have an additional \$2 billion dollars over the course of the current biennial budget and into the next budget cycle. I am enthusiastic to work with my fellow legislators and provide additional revenue to the state's Transportation Fund, education system, and cut taxes for hardworking Wisconsin families.
