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Rep. Petryk Statement on Passage of Pre-Existing Condition Guaranteed Coverage Act:

Madison – Today, the State Assembly passed bi-partisan legislation to protect Wisconsinites with pre-existing medical conditions. Regardless of what happens at the federal level, Wisconsin residents won't be denied access to life-saving treatment options or health insurance because of their prior medical history.

“Assembly Bill 1 codifies these protections into State statute. I fully support the Pre-Existing Condition Guaranteed Coverage Act to ensure that insurance companies cannot deny coverage to individuals because they have a pre-existing health condition, refuse to cover services to treat a pre-existing condition, or charge a higher premium based on a person's health history,” said Representative Warren Petryk (R-Eleva).

“This legislation addresses a critical need for many Wisconsinites. I'm proud to support this legislation and look forward to continuing to protect Wisconsin residents and provide affordable healthcare,” concluded Petryk.

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
