Knodl Votes to Protect Pre-Existing Conditions

Madison – Legislation to protect people with pre-existing conditions passed the Assembly today on a bipartisan vote of 76-19. Rep. Dan Knodl (R-Germantown) proudly voted in favor of this important reform and issued the following statement:

“Our first priority this session was to ensure Wisconsin law protects people with pre-existing conditions from losing their insurance coverage. Last session, I voted to protect coverage for pre-existing conditions, and I was proud to do so again in the Assembly today as AB 1 passed with overwhelming bipartisan support.

“We cannot always control what will happen at the federal level with regards to healthcare policy, and we should not leave our constituents at the mercy of inaction in Washington D.C. If the federal healthcare law is struck down, the legislation we passed today in the Assembly will ensure that protections for Wisconsinites with pre-existing conditions continue.

“This session, we need to continue finding common-sense solutions to lower the cost of healthcare and make it more affordable and accessible for everyone. I look forward to working with my colleagues in the Legislature and the Governor to find common ground and produce results for the residents of the 24th Assembly district and the state.”
