Re: Snow Emergency, January 28 & January 29, 2019

Per Section 94-216 of the municipal code, I'm declaring an extension of the **Snow Emergency in the City of Racine from 12:00 noon, Monday, January 28, 2019 to 8:00 A.M., Tuesday, January 29, 2019** to aid the city's snow removal operations.

This means there shall be no parking permitted on either side of the city's arterial and collector streets, and all cars must be parked on the **odd** side of all local streets from 12:00 midnight to 8:00 A.M. on Tuesday, January 29, 2019. **Vehicles parked in violation of these restrictions will be ticketed, and subject to towing.**

Again, the Snow Emergency will continue in effect from 12:00 noon Monday, January 28, 2019 through 8:00 A.M. Tuesday, January 29, 2019. Parking restrictions during this period will allow crews to remove as much snow as possible from city's streets.
