Milwaukee County Clerk Praises Lakefront Brewery’s Valentine’s Day Wedding Promotion, Reminds Couples They Need a Marriage License to Get Married Legally

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Clerk George L. Christenson issued a statement today supporting weddings at the Lakefront Brewery on Valentine’s Day but reminded couples that they still require a valid marriage license in order to get married legally in the State of Wisconsin.

“Few days are more fitting to say “I Do” than Valentine’s Day and I recognize Lakefront Brewery’s efforts to make this day even more special by facilitating free weddings. That being said, I want to remind couples who wish to take advantage of this opportunity that they still need to obtain a marriage license from the County Clerk’s Office in the county they reside in to get legally married in the State of Wisconsin,” Christenson said.

Milwaukee County residents may obtain their marriage license at the County Clerk’s Office, located at the **Milwaukee County Courthouse in Room 105 (901 N. 9th Street), Monday through Friday from 8AM until 4PM.** Couples must **apply in person** for their license **at least seven days prior** to the date of their wedding ceremony. The cost of a marriage license is **\$110.00.**
