Vukmir Project Labor Neutrality Bill Passes Senate

MADISON, Wis. — State Sen. Leah Vukmir’s legislation that establishes project labor neutrality passed the Wisconsin state Senate Wednesday.

Vukmir, R–Brookfield, and state Rep. Rob Hutton, R–Brookfield, worked closely together in crafting Senate Bill 3. This bill prevents state and local governments from mandating project labor agreements as a condition for bidding on a public works project.

“Senate Republicans took another positive step today toward freeing Wisconsinites from placating to the demands of those who believe only members of labor organizations should be considered to work on taxpayer-funded projects,” Vukmir said.

“This legislation establishes neutrality and fairness, a position all lawmakers should support. Wisconsin should not alienate any of our workforce. All qualified laborers deserve equal access.”

Vukmir represents portions of Waukesha and Milwaukee counties in the state Senate.
