Representative Zimmerman Sees Alignment To District Needs In Proposed Budget

Madison, WI Rep. Shannon Zimmerman (R-River Falls) released the following statement about Governor Walker's budget recommendations as presented before a joint session of the Wisconsin State Legislature.

Governor Walker proposed strategic investments into a variety of categories which coincide nicely to some of the key needs of Hudson, River Falls and Roberts. Areas such as K-12 Education, Higher Education and efforts to shrink government and bureaucracy so businesses can operate more efficiently and effectively were all featured in the Governor's proposed budget.
