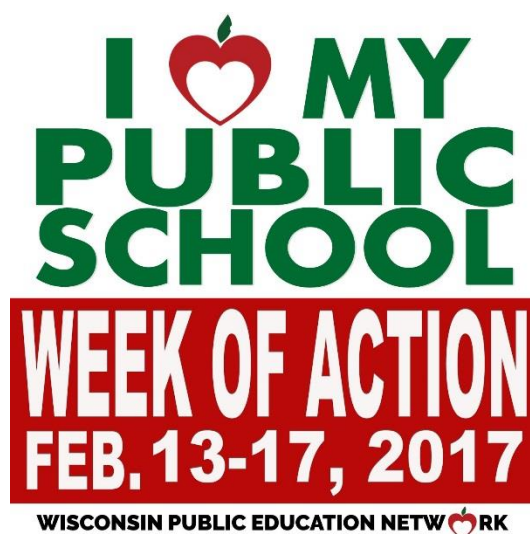
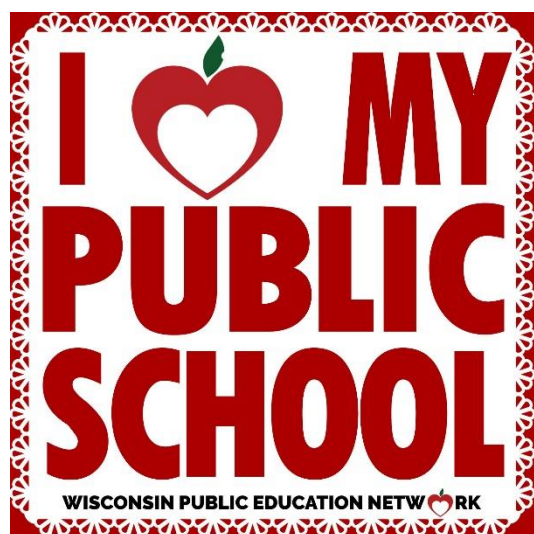
Wisconsin Celebrates I Love My Public School Week Feb 13-17
