Rep. Dittrich's Reaction to Governor Evers' Budget Address

Madison – Today, Representative Barbara Dittrich (*R-Oconomowoc*) shared her thoughts to Governor Evers's Budget Address.

“I was concerned and disappointed to hear how Governor Evers' budget harms our children, attempts to raise our taxes, and takes our state in the wrong direction. In his first few weeks in office, he talked about working together and the first chance he had to do so, he vetoed a tax cut for the middle class.
