On Wednesday, March 3, 2021, the Assembly Committee on Constitution and Ethics listened to a Public Hearing that lasted 8 hours, on several bills including: **Assembly Bill 23**, which would prohibit the Department of Health Services and local health officers from requiring individuals to receive a vaccine against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, and **AB 25**, which prohibits an employer from requiring an individual to receive a vaccine against the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus or show evidence of having received such a vaccine.

Wisconsin United For Freedom is appreciative of the committee members who showed up to work and listened to the concerns of Wisconsinites. We appreciate legislators who believe each individual must make the medical decisions they feel are right for them.

It is not right for the state to use its power to compel or mandate the use of liability free pharmaceutical products. Medical procedures, that carry very real risks, should always be voluntary, and citizens in our state should not face the threat of losing their financial security over making an informed medical decision.
