## **Shilling Praises Investments in Local Road Projects**

*Gov. Evers Announces Grants for Vernon, La Crosse and Monroe Counties*

MADISON, WI – Governor Tony Evers announced 152 local communities that will receive grant funding through the Multimodal Local Supplement (MLS) program. The program pays up to 90% of total eligible costs with local governments providing a minimum of 10% cost share. Funds are used for projects statewide related to roads, bridges, bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, railroads and harbors. La Crosse, Vernon and Monroe Counties were included in the list of grant recipients.

“A strong, safe and reliable transportation network is critical for boosting economic development and creating good-paying jobs,” said Senator Jennifer Shilling (D-La Crosse). “It’s great to see Governor Evers is ensuring these grants are being invested right here in western Wisconsin where back-to-back summers of significant flooding have severely impacted local roads and bridges.”

Grants through the MLS program have been awarded to the following projects:

- \$55,325 for Town of Genoa-Hickory Ridge Road in Vernon County
- \$51,132 for Town of Harmony-Dudley Hill Road Bridge in Vernon County
- \$400,000 for City of Hillsboro-Elm Ave in Vernon County
- \$314,997 for La Crosse CTH YY, I, T Bridges in La Crosse County
- \$1,000,000 for City of La Crosse-Palace and Larson Street in La Crosse County
- \$938,590 for Town of Jefferson-Ogden Road in Monroe County
- \$327,263 for Town of Portland-Oakland Rd Bridge in Monroe County
