## **Rep. Pocan Announces Sauk County Town Hall**

Madison – U.S. Rep. Mark Pocan (WI-02) will hold a Sauk County town hall this coming **Monday, March 13 from 5:30 – 6:30 pm**, to discuss his work in Congress, issues facing Sauk County and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District and field questions from attendees.

“I am pleased to invite my constituents to attend this Sauk County Town Hall to share their ideas and concerns,” Rep. Pocan said. “Current political changes have led to a major increase in calls to our office from communities all over our district and it is more important than ever that elected officials be accessible to the people they serve. I look forward to being able to talk about the topics we hear about daily in a face-to-face town hall setting.”

This will be his third town hall since the new Congressional session began in January. In recent months, Rep.
