New project management bachelor degree concentration

(Janesville, Wis.) Students enrolling in the Bachelor of Applied Arts and Sciences (BAAS) degree-completion program at University of Wisconsin-Rock County this fall can now choose coursework with a concentration in project management.

“The brand new project management concentration is an opportunity for individuals to develop the skills necessary to manage complex projects,” Karen Greenler, senior student services coordinator and academic advisor of the BAAS program at UW-Rock County, explains. “This concentration prepares students through courses like Project Management Simulation,” Greenler continues.

BAAS is a bachelor’s degree that can be earned at UW-Rock County. Classes are taught both in-person and online by faculty from UW-Rock County and other partnering campuses.
