Operation Drive Sober Results in 11 Arrests, Wrong Way Driver 1708 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. ordered a continued an aggressive Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative, from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through Sunday at 6:00 a.m., resulted in the arrest of 11 drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .13.

One repeat offender was arrested: Martin Huerta, age 33, of Wauwatosa, for DUI-2nd.
