## **Locksmiths Schedule Legislative Briefing Session**

### ***Security Systems, Consumer Fraud and Scamming to be Discussed***

The Locksmith Alliance of Wisconsin (LAW) will conduct a Legislative Day in the State Capitol on Tuesday, March 14th. A part of the day's agenda will be devoted to an open discussion of emerging issues concerning the industry.

There will be an open legislative briefing session from 1:00 p.m. until 2:00 p.m. in Room 400 N.E. in the State Capitol. All Legislative offices have been invited to participate.

The Locksmith Alliance of Wisconsin is seeking to remedy serious issues of consumer scamming, fraudulent "locksmithing" business practices and the lack of oversight by any designated regulatory state agency.

The LAW will have on hand individuals who have been involved in the traditional practices of what is called locksmithing. This will also include representatives of institutional locksmiths who serve the public through employment in schools, universities, childcare institutions, nursing homes and correctional institutions.
