WisMed statement on Interstate Medical Licensure Compact

Society President Molli Rolli, MD, issued the statement below following today's Senate Health and Human Services hearing on Senate Bill 74, which ensures that Wisconsin can remain a part of the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact:

“The drive to improve Wisconsin’s physician workforce deficit has many fronts. The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact is one of those tools that can help cut through needless red tape when a physician wishes to be licensed to practice in Wisconsin.
