“Sanctuary Cities” Bill Dies on the Last Day of Senate Session

MADISON – The so-called Sanctuary Cities Bill, AB 450, died yesterday after not being taken up for a vote on the last day of Senate session. Representative JoCasta Zamarripa (D-Milwaukee) issued the following statement,

“AB 450, the anti-immigrant so-called sanctuary cities bill, is dead. It will not become law this year. This is a victory for all Wisconsinites and I want to credit the 20,000 Latino Wisconsinites and their allies who called, wrote, and came to the Capitol to voice their opposition to anti-immigrant legislation that was advancing through our legislature.”

“But it’s not over. A second anti-immigrant bill, SB 533, which would ban municipalities from issuing Local ID Cards, is currently on Gov. Walker’s desk ready for him to sign. I am asking Wisconsinites to call or write Gov.
