## **Rep. Hutton's Statement on The Assembly Extraordinary Session**

Madison – Representative Rob Hutton (R-Brookfield) issued the following statement on the Assembly extraordinary session.

“Today the Assembly returned in extraordinary session to pass several important pieces of pro-business, pro-family, pro-school legislation,” said Rep. Hutton.

“Several bills are now on their way to the Governor’s office as a result of the votes taken in the Assembly today. We passed legislation that will improve the business climate in the State and create an environment that encourages employers to continue to do business in our State.”

“We also passed legislation that will send surplus tax money back where it belongs, to the hardworking taxpayers of our State. The \$100 per child tax credit will be a huge benefit to parents as they are buying back to school supplies.”

“In addition the Wisconsin Assembly passed legislation making our schools safer. In light of recent events around the nation it is imperative that we take steps to ensure that our children are safe. This legislation accomplishes that purpose by providing grants to our schools for them to use to improve security, creating a dedicated office of school safety, and mandating the reporting of threats to schools.”
