

Hi Mark,

I received some information from the DPI about districts that received Impact Aid in 2014-15. (I've also included the 2013-14 amounts below for comparison purposes.) I found it surprising how much the aid amounts varied from year to year. It also surprised me that while most districts saw an increase from 2013-14 to 2014-15 as overall funding increased by nearly \$4 million, several districts (e.g., Gresham, Shawano, Tomah, Unity, Winter) actually received less in 2014-15.

If I am understanding things correctly, the following Wisconsin school districts received Impact Aid in 2015:
