REPRESENTATIVE HINTZ WELCOMES GOVERNOR EVERS TO OSHKOSH

The Governor has been all across Wisconsin listening to constituents to hear how the proposed budget impacts everyday people in our state. Representative Gordon Hintz (D-Oshkosh) released the following statement welcoming the Governor and Lieutenant Governor to the city of Oshkosh in the 54th Assembly District:
