Local Students to Participate in Mock Trial as Part of Youth Government Day

KEWAUNEE, WI – A pre-selected group of nearly two dozen high school students from Algoma, Kewaunee and Luxemburg School Districts will participate in a mock trial as part of the 55th annual “Youth Government Day” in Kewaunee County on May 1st.

The program is designed to teach students about the inner workings of local government and to encourage them to become well-informed and active citizens of the community.

Throughout the course of the day, Kewaunee County’s elected officials will meet with students to provide them some insight on their duties and give tours of their offices, which includes the Courthouse, Sheriff’s Department, and Administration Center.

“The goal is to teach these students the functions of county government and how we as elected officials serve the community,” says Jamie Annoye, Kewaunee County Clerk.
