Board of Review sets new course with Evans as chair

The Office of the Assessor has announced that Attorney Roy B. Evans has been elected to serve as chair of the City of Milwaukee Board of Review.

Mr. Evans was elected during the board's annual organizational meeting on Monday, April 23, pursuant to state statutes. Mr. Evans is a graduate of North Division High School, holds B.A. and M.S. degrees in Education, and a Law Degree (JD) from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He previously served as chair of the City's Administrative Review Appeals Board.

"It's an honor to have been asked to take on this important leadership role by my peers and I look forward to continued service to the taxpayers and the City of Milwaukee," Mr. Evans said.

The Board of Review is an independent quasi-judicial body of city residents appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Common Council. It is the Board's duty to hear tax assessment objections and to decide whether the assessment is correct based on the evidence presented. An objection must be filed by requesting an objection form and returning the completed form to the City of Milwaukee Assessor's Office by the 3rd Monday in May (**May 21, 2018**).

"The board is well prepared to continue its important work and I look forward to leading and guiding the body forward," Mr. Evans said.
