## **FEP Statement on Supreme Court's rejection of partisan map-rigging rules petition**

MILWAUKEE— Fair Elections Project Director Sachin Chheda released the following statement in response to the decision by the State Supreme Court to reject a proposed rule petition to create unfair, partisan rules for redistricting.

“The State Supreme Court has made the right decision in denying the effort to rig the map-drawing process through a ridiculously partisan proposed rule. The legislature should now commit to an open, honest, transparent, and fair process to draw and approve district maps for the next decade. The people deserve nothing less.”
