Democrats poised to flip another GOP seat

Senate Dem candidate Caleb Frostman emerges as SD 1 frontrunner

STURGEON BAY, WI - Senate Democratic candidate Caleb Frostman emerged from Tuesday's primary election as the clear frontrunner in the race for the 1st Senate District. Voters have rallied behind his candidacy which has focused on strengthening local schools, expanding access to health care and restoring tax fairness.

"Across Wisconsin, voters are organizing and turning out to elect strong, pro-growth Democratic candidates," said Jenni Dye, SSDC Executive Director. "Caleb has shown he has what it takes to create economic opportunities and good, family-supporting jobs in his community. From protecting clean drinking water to expanding job training programs, voters know they can trust Caleb to fight for their interests and represent their values in the State Senate."

With strong momentum heading into the June 12th general election, Caleb Frostman is positioned to become the second Democrat to flip a Republican-held Senate seat this year. Senate Democrats have led the fight for change at the ballot box and made national headlines after flipping the bright red SD 10 seat earlier this year and putting SD 1 in play. As voters increasingly look to Democratic leadership to chart a positive path forward, Republicans are bracing for a tough election cycle as they fight to hold legislative seats across Wisconsin.

"The bruising attacks between Jacque and Renard have exposed serious divisions among an increasingly unpopular Republican Party," added Dye. "Residents across Wisconsin have shown they are tired of the broken Republican promises and unfair tax breaks that benefit foreign corporations and the wealthy. With Tuesday's results, it's clear that Democrats are on the move and ready to build on our momentum all the way to November."
