**Rep. Loudenbeck Statement on State Property Tax Cut**

**Madison, WI** –Rep. Amy Loudenbeck (R-Clinton) released the following statement regarding Governor Scott Walker’s proposal to eliminate the state’s property tax, also known as the forestry mill tax.

“I share the Governor’s desire to reduce the overall property tax burden in Wisconsin and will be supporting the proposal to eliminate the forestry mill tax when it comes before the Joint Finance Committee (JFC).
