



Rep. Wachs Responds to News That Foxconn is Cutting Its Investment in Wisconsin

EAU CLAIRE – Rep. Dana Wachs, a Democratic challenger to Gov. Scott Walker in November, responded to [news released this morning in the Nikkei Asian Review](#) that Foxconn plans to cut its investment in Wisconsin. The article released this morning notes that the change would allow Foxconn to reduce its need to do business with Wisconsin suppliers.
