## **Manitowoc Businesswoman Receives Trailblazer Awards**

**Madison:** Lynn Seidl-Babcock, owner of HomeCare Health Services & Hospice and Manitowoc HomeCare, received both a Forward Award and a Pioneer Award at the 2018 Governor’s Trailblazer Awards for Women in Business ceremony at the Wisconsin State Capitol today.
