Steil Officially Files for First Congressional District *Submits maximum number of nomination signatures*

JANESVILLE — Today, Bryan Steil submitted over 2,000 nomination signatures to officially place him on the ballot for Wisconsin’s First Congressional District.

“This is a grassroots effort and I am proud of our team’s hard work. As I’m out collecting signatures, it is clear, voters want a problem solver in Washington,” said Steil.

Steil’s campaign noted its growing momentum across all corners of the district and highlighted the hundreds of signatures collected from all six counties. Wisconsin election law requires 1,000 signatures and allows a maximum of 2,000 signatures for Candidates for the U.S. House of Representatives.

Bryan Steil was born and raised in Janesville, Wisconsin. He is a member of the University of Wisconsin Board of Regents and has a strong background as a business leader. For the past nine years Bryan has worked for manufacturing companies in Rock County and has learned the importance of fiscal discipline and risks of government red tape.
