BRITTANY KEYES ON THE BALLOT FOR 31ST ASSEMBLY DISTRICT RACE

Dr. Brittany Keyes, a Democrat running for Wisconsin's 31st Assembly District, has qualified to be on the ballot for the 2018 election.

Keyes lives in Beloit with her husband and infant daughter. Keyes, a physical therapist and high school coach employed by Beloit Health System, turned in 572 signatures to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. The required number of valid signatures was 200. "My volunteers and I enjoyed the process of meeting people, getting the word out, and gathering signatures," Keyes said. "I am really encouraged by the enthusiasm for new ideas and better government."

Keyes announced that retired State Senator Judy Robson, and former Rock County Board Supervisor Rev. Steve Howland, will serve as campaign co-chairs. Her campaign treasurer is retired Beloit City Council President David Luebke.

Keyes will continue her grassroots approach, visiting every corner of her district.

"We are hitting the doors and not slowing down," Keyes said. "We are out meeting voters, listening to them, and recruiting volunteers. This is what democracy should look like."

Keyes, a health care provider, will emphasize improving access to affordable health care, repairing damage to the educational system, protecting the environment, and creating a more sensible strategy for economic development and infrastructure.

"As a mother, I want to help build a better Wisconsin for my daughter and the next generation," Keyes said. "Our children are our future and worth the work necessary to rebuild a safe, healthy and sustainable Wisconsin."

"The way to build our economy is through decent roads, great schools, top-notch universities, access to

high speed internet and quality health care,” Keyes added. “We need to re-prioritize and support job creators like the tourism industry, high tech entrepreneurs and our agriculture industry. We need to get back to the basics and reflect our common sense Wisconsin values.”

Keyes also promised to fight for accountable government, including non-partisan redistricting reform. “This district is one of the most gerrymandered in the state,” Keyes said. “Voters should choose their representatives, not the other way around.”

The 31st Assembly District includes parts of the City and Town of Beloit and City of Janesville, the Village of Clinton, and surrounding towns in Rock County. In Walworth County the district includes the City of Elkhorn, the villages of Darien, Fontana-on-Geneva Lake, Sharon, Walworth, and Williams Bay, and surrounding towns.

“I look forward to meeting the voters, talking about issues important to families, and working hard to be accountable to taxpayers,” said Keyes.
