Rep. Jesse Kremer Endorses Ty Bodden for the 59th Assembly District - Response

St. Cloud – Current 59th Assembly District Representative, Jesse Kremer, endorses Ty Bodden to fill his seat in Madison. Rep. Jesse Kremer was elected to the Assembly in the fall of 2014 and is not seeking a third term in office.

Rep. Kremer issued the following statement regarding Ty, “I am proud to support Ty Bodden and endorse him as my family’s next representative and the voice of the entire 59th Assembly District in Madison.
