Skowronski—Wisconsin FW Legislator of the Year.

MADISON — Representative Ken Skowronski, Wisconsin's Assembly District 82 has been awarded the Wisconsin VFW Legislator of the Year award for "Outstanding Service to our State's Veterans." Skowronski was presented a plaque by then Commander, Gundel Metz during General Session at this year's VFW State Convention on Friday, June 14th in Appleton at the Red Lion Hotel.

Wisconsin is one of America's best states for Veterans to live because of the education, tax and quality healthcare benefits available to active and retired military. Skowronski is the Chair for Wisconsin's Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs. He has strongly advocated for the successful passing of several bills in Wisconsin and currently sponsors bills affecting Veterans including student protection from late VA payments.
