Foxconn Selects Appleton's Boldt Company for Architecture

APPLETON, WI — Foxconn Technology Group announced today that the Boldt Company, located in Appleton, Wisconsin, has received a contract for architectural work on the first building in the Wisconsin Valley Science and Technology Park. The 120,000 square foot multipurpose project in Mount Pleasant, Wisconsin is valued at \$14 million. Seven other Wisconsin companies were also awarded contracts as part of the construction project. A groundbreaking ceremony for the park will be held tomorrow.

State Representative Dave Murphy (R-Greenville) issued the following statement:

“After thorough deliberation, I came to support Foxconn because of the jobs and economic growth it will bring to the Fox Valley.
