Rep. Plumer Statement on 2021 Act 58

MADISON, WI – Rep. Plumer (R – Lodi) released the following statement after Governor Evers signed the biennial state budget into law yesterday:

“This biennium’s budget is something all Wisconsinites can be proud of. This budget makes a historic tax cut of \$3.4 billion, while still making increased investments in transportation, mental health, and broadband. Additionally, we were able to return education funding to the two-thirds level the state had guaranteed in the past.

“For the first time in over a decade the state budget passed with votes from both parties and we didn’t have to compromise our values to get there. This budget deserved to be signed into law without any partial vetoes, but I am glad Governor Evers decided to sign this common sense, bi-partisan legislation into law.”
