## **Planned Parenthood Advocates of Wisconsin Responds to Supreme Court Nomination**

**MADISON** – Statement from Nicole Safar, Executive Director of Planned Parenthood Advocates of Wisconsin:

“With his nomination of Judge Brett Kavanaugh to the U.S. Supreme Court, President Donald Trump has put a woman’s ability to make her own health care decisions on the line. The president has promised to only nominate Justices who will vote to overturn *Roe v. Wade*, the landmark decision that prohibited states from outlawing abortion. If that happens, abortion will immediately become a crime in Wisconsin.

“The next Supreme Court Justice will determine the course of our history, and the course of countless women’s lives. Any nominee who does not believe that a woman should be able to make her own health care decisions disagrees with the vast majority of people in this country and is not qualified to serve as a Justice on the Supreme Court.

“We urge the Senate to take their confirmation duties seriously. You’ll be hearing from us.”
