ABC of Wisconsin recognizes Senator Chris Kapenga for 'Building Wisconsin'

Pewaukee, WI – On Wednesday, July 18th Senator Chris Kapenga (R-Delafield) was presented with the 2018 “Building Wisconsin” award at Zignego Company in Pewaukee. Zignego is a local family owned company headquartered in Waukesha County that has been building urban, highway and interstate construction projects throughout the state since 1954. The award is presented by Associated Builders and Contractors (ABC) of Wisconsin to recognize legislative leadership in enacting legislation that benefits the state’s construction industry.

During the 2017-2018 legislative session Senator Kapenga authored Act 148, which expands apprenticeship opportunities in our state by allowing more workers to enter into apprenticeships that provide the training for family-sustaining jobs. Senator Kapenga also supported efforts this session to level the playing field and save taxpayer dollars by supporting project-labor agreement neutrality and repealing Wisconsin’s prevailing wage law.

Senator Kapenga represents the 33rd Senate District, which covers all or parts of the following communities: Chenequa, Delafield, Dousman, Geneseo, Hartland, Merton, Nasbotat, North Prairie, Ottawa, Pewaukee, Oconomowoc Lake, Summit, Sussex and Waukesha.
