Deputies Arrest 6 in Operation Drive Sober County Supervisor Cited for OWI-1st 1965 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt continues an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This past weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. Monday, resulted in the arrest of six drunken drivers. The average PBT test results were .16.

Three repeat offenders were arrested: Romualdo Simion-Galindo, age 38, of West Allis, for OWI-3rd; and two OWI-2nd arrests - Kenneth Thompson, age 35, of Milwaukee; and Jeremiah Wilson, age 30, of West Allis.

First-time offenders taken into custody were Lashon Luellen, age 27, of Milwaukee; Marcelia Nicholson, age 30, of Milwaukee; and Alexandra Peer-Drake, age 24, of Franklin.

Just after midnight today, Milwaukee County Supervisor Marcelia Nicholson crashed her car into the median wall and came to rest in lane #1 on I-43 southbound at W. National Avenue. Deputies found that she showed signs of impairment and conducted field sobriety tests. She admitted to drinking one drink, and tested a .18 on the intoximeter.

Nicholson received citations for OWI-1st, and Failure to Control Motor Vehicle.
