H.H. Bennett Studio Holds Photo Contest to Celebrate "Wisconsin's Best" Outdoor Scenery

Wisconsin Dells, Wis. – H.H. Bennett Studio, a Wisconsin Historical Society site, is holding a photo contest, "Wisconsin's Best", to celebrate the range of diversity of Wisconsin's great outdoors.

"This is a chance for anyone to show off their photography skills and celebrate the outdoor places in Wisconsin that are important to them," said David Rambow, site director at H.H. Bennett Studio. "The three finalists chosen will each receive a cash prize, but all entrants will receive their high quality display photo and receive commission on any of their prints sold."

The "Wisconsin's Best" photography contest and exhibition is hosted at H.H. Bennett Studio in partnership with Be Kind Studios. The contest is open to all ages and all levels of photographic skill. All entries must be photographs, with minimal editing and corrections (otherwise subject to disqualification). Photographic entries will be printed on acid-free, archival matte fine art paper (16"x 20") and will be displayed in the Reese Gallery of H. H. Bennett Studio during the exhibition. The three winners of the contest will be determined by the number of prints sold during the exhibition.

The exhibition and photo contest runs through Saturday, October 21 and is open to all ages and photographic skill level. On Saturday, October 28, first, second and third prize winners will be awarded. All entries must be submitted by Saturday, August 26. The cost of submission is \$40 per person per photograph.
