### **Deputies Arrest 12 in Operation Drive Sober 1975 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010**

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff Richard R. Schmidt continues an aggressive Operating While Intoxicated (OWI- drugs and/or alcohol) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of intoxicated drivers. This past weekend's Operation Drive Sober initiative from Friday at 4:00 p.m. through 6:00 a.m. Monday, resulted in the arrest of 12 drunken drivers. The average PBT test results were .14.

Sheriff Schmidt said, "Deputies took a dozen more drunken drivers off the freeway this weekend, with four repeat offenders who haven't learned a lesson. We're out every day to keep law-abiding motorists safe."

Four repeat offenders were arrested: Vincent Lea, age 30, of Greenfield, for OWI-3<sup>rd</sup>; and Milwaukee residents Matthew Hernandez, age 22; Eldridge House, age 35; and Edgar Velez, age 49; all for OWI-2<sup>nd</sup> offense.

First-time offenders were: Leonarda Dominguez Lopez, age 28, of West Allis; Sarah Fogl, age 23, of Mukwonago; Lamera Franklin, age 41, of Muskegon; Ross Johnson, age 38, of Brookfield; and Milwaukee residents: Andrew Schmidt, age 28; Erin Colella, age 30; Justin Gold, age 36; and Allison Kaltenbrun, age 18.
