As you are aware, the intense storms with torrential rains that have passed through the districts we represent have caused significant damage to roads, bridges, and property throughout the region and led to at least one death. Many roads in the area remain impassable and are bringing people's lives to a halt. The communities affected by these storms are overwhelmed by the level of damage and will need as much assistance as possible in their cleanup and repair efforts.

Again, thank you for considering this urgent request. We hope that you will formally declare a State of Emergency to help provide relief to the communities we represent.
